Guidelines for Teachers

GENERAL

- **Every school will have a limit of 30 student entries per building /one per student**
- All awards will be jointly presented from all three sponsoring organizations highlighting the best student work in our communities
- All student work will have identical labels placed in the bottom right corner, (your school logo is allowed and encouraged) A template for this student label is provided on this website
- All work will be matted: minimum 2" maximum 3" (Notebook paper is not appropriate matting material)
- There will be an online portal at check-in for last minute entries - all lists must match.

ELEMENTARY

- Elementary Show includes grades 2 – 5, (no kindergarten or first grade)
- Every participating student will receive a certificate of participation – these will be given to teachers to distribute
- **AWARDS**
1st place, Art Supplies Bundle
2nd place, Art Supplies Bundle
3rd place, Art Supplies Bundle
One Community Award per school, \$50 scholarship

MIDDLE SCHOOL

- Grades 6-8 will be displayed in the River Walk Gallery, arranged by categories, (not schools). Krasl and Box Factory will design and hang the show. Teachers can drop off student work between 2 pm and 6 pm.
- Categories will include:
Three Dimensional: glass, jewelry, sculpture, ceramics, mixed media
Two Dimensional: photography, painting (watercolor, acrylic, oil), drawing (pencil, pen, graphite, ink, colored pencil, pastels, markers), mixed media (mixed media meaning: more than 1 media)
Media Arts: Must be submitted using youtube. Can not be longer than 5 minutes. Must be appropriate for all ages.
- Every participating student will receive a certificate of participation - these will be given to teachers to distribute
- **AWARDS**
1st place 2D, \$50
2nd place 2D, \$25
1st place 3D, \$50
2nd place 3D, \$25
Al Farmer Award , amount to be determined
One Community Award per school, \$50 scholarship

HIGH SCHOOL

- Grades 9-12 will be displayed in the first floor of the Box Factory, arranged by categories, (not schools). Krasl and Box Factory will design and hang the show. Teachers can drop off student work between 2 pm and 6 pm.
- Categories will include:
 - Three Dimensional: glass, jewelry, sculpture, ceramics, mixed media
 - Two Dimensional: photography, painting (watercolor, acrylic, oil), drawing (pencil, pen, graphite, ink colored pencil, pastels, markers), mixed media (mixed media meaning: more than 1 media)
 - Media Arts: Must be submitted using youtube. Can not be longer than 5 minutes. Must be appropriate for all ages
- Every participating student will receive a certificate of participation - these will be given to teachers to distribute
- AWARDS
 - 1st place 2D, \$100
 - 2nd place 2D, \$50
 - 1st place 3D, \$100
 - 2nd place 3D, \$50
 - Sara E. Cayo Award, \$500
 - One Community Award per school, \$50 scholarship
